RESOLUTION OF THE OGLALA SIOUX TRIBAL COUNCIL  
OF THE OGLALA SIOUX TRIBE  
(An Unincorporated Tribe)

RESOLUTION OF THE OGLALA SIOUX TRIBAL COUNCIL SUPPORTING DEVELOPMENT OF GENERAL MANAGEMENT PLAN FOR SOUTH UNIT OF BADLANDS NATIONAL MONUMENT.

WHEREAS, the Oglala Sioux Tribe was organized under Section 16 of the 1934 Indian Reorganization Act by adopting a federally approved constitution and by-laws, and

WHEREAS, Article IV, Section 1(a) of the Tribal Constitution authorized the Tribal Council "to negotiate with the Federal, State, and local governments on behalf of the tribe", and "to advised and consult with the representatives of the Interior Department on all activities of the Department that may affect the Pine Ridge Reservation", and Article IV, Section 1(m) empowers the Tribal Council "to protect and preserve the property, wild life and natural resources of the tribe", and

WHEREAS, the Land and Natural Resources Committee of the Tribal Council, along with the tribally chartered Oglala Sioux parks and Recreation Authority and the National Park Service have begun development of a General Management Plan for the South Unit, which includes a preferred alternative involving more active and culturally relevant tribal management and a cultural heritage center, and

WHEREAS, under the process being utilized to develop the General Management Plan, a public comment period will be initiated, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council desires to support the continued development of the General Management Plan under the current process, for the benefit of the Tribe, its members, and its resources in the former bombing range areas now identified as the South Unit, now

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Oglala Sioux Tribal Council does hereby acknowledge that the process of government-to-government consultation on the issue of the General Management Plan has been initiated, and charges the Oglala Sioux Parks and Recreation Authority and the Land and Natural Resources Committee to continue to consult with the National Park Service throughout the General Management Plan development process, and to keep the full Tribal Council apprised of developments as they occur, so that final approval by the Tribal Council and the people will be well-formed.
